### f. *Special Activity Membership*

i. A Non-Voting, Non-Launch Special Activity Membership would be open to persons whose boat ownership is limited to the type of boat, i.e. canoes, kayaks, stand up paddle boards or at the discretion of the Board of Directors capable of being placed on an existing rack for storage. The Board of Directors shall set the annual dues for the Special Activity Membership at the annual meeting and the established rack rental fee will be assessed for each boat to be stored. In addition to the use of the rack, the membership shall include parking and Clubhouse access. This membership shall not require an initiation fee; dues are payable annually. A Special Activity Membership shall have a maximum term of two years and the member shall not be eligible to hold office nor chair any committee. At the discretion of the Board, all assessments, (including the Work assessment), except those specifically applied to the boat storage rack, shall be waived for this special membership category. Application for such memberships shall be made to the Board of Directors through the membership committee. Special Activity Members who wish to remain members of the Setauket Yacht Club after the expiration of two years will be required to pay the initiation fee and apply for regular membership. If at any time during the term of the membership, the Special Activity Member wishes to convert to a Non-Launch or Launch member, the member may apply for regular membership in the club. Upon acceptance, the initiation fee is to be paid in full, along with the difference between the Special Activity Membership dues and regular membership dues.
